## An Inspector Calls - Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2019

At our school, we understand that learning outside of the school environment is a valuable and effective means of enhancing the curriculum and pupils' learning, understanding and personal and social development.

In light of the above, we are planning an educational trip to the New Wimbledon Theatre in London for Year 11.

The trip will be to see an evening performance of An Inspector Calls on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2019. We will travel by coach, leaving school around 15:30 and returning around midnight. This play is part of the GCSE Literature syllabus and will be a wonderful opportunity to see it performed live. School uniform **must** be worn.

As per the Trust's Charging Policy, in order to ensure that this opportunity is available to our pupils, we would like to ask for a voluntary contribution of **£34** from the parents & carers. The cost includes return transport to and from the New Wimbledon Theatre.

Unfortunately, the school does not have the available financial resources to fund this visit so if we are unable to cover the full cost from contributions, we may have to cancel the trip.

No student will be excluded from the trip on the grounds of cost alone and parents who would like their child to take part but who are experiencing financial difficulties at the present time should contact Student Services. However, acceptance of payment does not guarantee a place on the visit and we reserve the right to refuse a particular student a place on the grounds of their current poor behaviour or attitude. Students who are withdrawn from the trip because of poor behaviour may not be able to have their payment refunded.
