### Summary Risk Assessment

The school's Risk Assessment details the full range of measures which will be put in place.

At Step 4 of the government's roadmap for unlocking it is no longer a requirement for students to be kept in consistent groups 'bubbles' or for our school community to wear face-coverings in school.

The measures that are particularly relevant are set out below.

#### Key Control Measures:

- Each student will complete two supervised lateral flow tests at the start of the Academic year [LFT Risk Assessment](#);
- Twice weekly home-testing (This will be reviewed at the end of September);
- Staff and students will be expected to clean hands thoroughly, more often than usual;
- Good respiratory hygiene will be expected by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach;
- Enhanced cleaning, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often;
- Students are encouraged to bring their own basic equipment to school to minimise sharing;
- There will be limited mixing of social groups during social times;
- Staggered lunch;
- In all classrooms, tables will be, where possible, in rows facing the front of the class;
- Staff and students may wear face-coverings, if they wish;
- If a student exhibits symptoms they will be moved to our Covid Medical room and the classroom will be cleaned immediately;
- Teachers will have sufficient space at the front of the room, but will circulate the room, as needed.

**The school may decide to re-introduce measures if there is an outbreak in school as advised by Public Health England.**
